## Animals for Africa

Jeannette Cadets, an after school program at Myhre Elementary School, are completing work on an Animals for Africa project. Myhre students are working with the Spanish Club from BHS and its advisor, Gina Solemsaas.

A former student from Bismarck High has been in the Peace Corps in Africa since October 2008. She is in a remote village with no electricity or running water. There are hundreds of children in her village, and a high rate of mortality among children, so families have 6 or more. They have trouble feeding them in the dry season. The children have no toys. The two school groups are collecting and sorting stuffed animals to send, as well as making and stuffing dolls for these children.
